Caverion has signed a new Large Project and Technical Maintenance agreement with one of the world's leading passenger and logistics companies Deutsche Bahn AG. Caverion will provide building systems and Technical Maintenance for a new maintenance center for trains in Cologne, Germany. The order has a volume of approximately EUR 19 million.

Caverion's delivery covers Project Execution for the following technical disciplines: Heating and Sanitation, Ventilation and Air Conditioning, Cooling and Automation. After completion in May 2017, Caverion will take care of the Technical Maintenance of the 230,000 m2 area.
