The St1 Marienlyst energy station in Oslo, Norway, is the first energy station in the Nordics that has switched to 100% electric from fossil fuels. As a market leader in the installation and maintenance of charging stations in Norway, Caverion has played a central role in the development of this new fast-charging facility.

The new facility has a transformer capacity of 1600 kVA and a total charging capacity of 1200 kW distributed over 12 charging points, setting a new standard for fast charging in urban areas.
